Purpose of the Job:

Operations position as ROV Technical Manager within the ROV Equipment Department you will be responsible for managing the ROV workshop and providing project and engineering support to all our operations. You will be responsible for the technical performance of the company's ROV including maintenance, repairs, spares inventories etc. Managing a team of workshop technicians and being responsible for liaising with project managers in planning and execution of projects, personnel, supervising third parties.

Candidates should have previous experience covering all aspects of ROV system technical related disciplines including knowledge of electronics, high voltage, hydraulics and mechanics.

Previous experience in a similar related capacity including position requiring supervisory and management skills is required.

- To ensure that the stores facility maintains stock levels and stock database system in accordance with company procedures.
- Recruitment of all base facility workshop, stores and certification support personnel.

- Liaise with project managers and workshop departments in the allocation of ROV plant and equipment.
